**COUNT 1**

(Attempted Transfer of Obscene Matter to a Minor)

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

On or about April 7, 2004, in the District of South Carolina, **DEREK COAXUM**, using facilitates and means of interstate and foreign commerce, that is, computerized access to the Internet, did knowingly attempt to transfer obscene matter to an individual who had not obtained the age of 16, knowing that individual had not attained the age of 16;
